Friday 1st - Friday 8th May 2020


This week your project is to find out about and explore 'Minibeasts'.

Here are some suggestions of activities you could do for your project -

1. Listen to stories on YouTube such as 'Mad About Minibeasts', 'The Minibeast Bop', 'Superworm', 'Snail and the Whale', 'What the Ladybird Heard' etc.
2. Go on a minibeast hunt in your garden/yard. Enjoy closely looking at, observing and handling the minibeasts you find (don't forget to wash your hands afterwards). Make a list of the minibeast names.





Choose a minibeast that you like the best and carry out an internet search of facts about that minibeast - what the different parts of its body are called, where it lives, what it likes to eat etc. Write some super sentences about what you have found out, maybe create a fact file or create a poster using pictures to show your findings.





6. Draw and label a picture of your favourite minibeast.




7. Create your own bug hotel to keep in the garden/yard, for a safe place for the minibeasts to live in.
